

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Owners and riders must be “Full” financial members of the NCHA Inc at the time of nomination and at time of competition.
- Aged event entries are to follow age specifications set by NCHA rule book.
- Payouts as per NCHA Rule Book.
- 15% of entry fees will be deducted for administration purposes and NCHA Levy.
- Online Entries Only will be accepted.
- Closing date for entries is the 4<sup>th</sup> August 2017 no refunds will be issued after this date.
- Open Futurity & Open Derby top 75% go through to 2<sup>nd</sup> Go Round.
- Open Classic - One Go Round. Top 30% to Final.
- NP Futurity, NP Derby & NP Classic Challenge Two Go Rounds plus final
- Cattle hire is an added cost to **ALL FINALISTS**
- Prize money will be withheld until all outstanding monies are paid – prize money will be paid to designated person on entry form.
- All late entries will incur a \$110 late fee.
- The CCCC reserves the right to cancel these competitions without liability and return all entry fees paid at any time should unforeseen circumstances occur.
- Pending on cattle numbers the committee reserves the right to cancel the following events Open & Open Non Pro in doing so all monies will be refunded.
- Two practice pens will be operational throughout the duration of the show. Under no circumstances will competitors have access to practice pens unless you have purchased a ticket at the show office in the way of cash payment or completed a practice pen authority form & have arranged with show secretary payment in the form of a signed blank cheque.

### Amateur Classes

- NCHA sponsored buckle to the highest scoring amateur in final.
- a) The CCCC 2017 Futurity will host Finals in the Amateur Futurity, Amateur Derby and Amateur Classic Challenge.
- b) Horses will qualify through the go rounds of the Non Pro Futurity, Non Pro Derby and Non Pro Classic Challenge. Entries are required to qualify for the 2nd Go Round.
- c) A separate final will be held for each event.
- d) Amateur Finals will have three head of cattle per competitor.
- c) \$1000 added per Amateur event.
- d) 6 horses plus ties will advance to the final, with all finalists receiving prizemoney. This overrides Rule 15, page 48 of the current NCHA Rule book.
