CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All events will be ran as per the NCHA rule book

Order of Events subject to change at the discretion of the committee

Stable use is at no charge – in return they are to be left clean. Manure dumps will be indicated for use

Price monies will be paid via direct deposit into the account details provided by iCompete- it is the responsibility of the owner to ensure these are correct along with the GST status.

All competitors, lopers and handlers must be NCHA members – full, loper or day membership

NRCHC will be using the one minute clock during the show and wish for all to adhere to this rule or be fined \$220 inc GST. Please see below from NCHA Rulebook

Each horse is allotted two and one-half (2 ½) minutes to work during a run. The working time starts when the rider crosses the official timeline. As soon as the horse, owner and rider's name are called to the herd by the announcer (the "rider announcement"), the timekeeper will start the 1-2 ½ minute clock to let the rider know how much time the rider must cross the official time line and begin the rider's run. b) If the rider has helped the contestant immediately preceding the rider's run or has drawn back-to-back in the working order, the rider will have 2½ minutes from the rider announcement to cross the official timeline and start their run. c) If the rider has not helped the contestant immediately preceding the rider's run or has not drawn back-to-back in the working order, the rider will have 1 minute from the time of the rider announcement to cross the official timeline and start their run. d) If the rider fails to cross the official timeline in the time allotted under the 1-2 ½ minute clock, a buzzer will sound and on additional minute will be added to the 1- 2 ½ minute clock. (This is the only warning that the rider will receive relating to the 1 - 2 ½ minute clock.) e) If the rider receives any additional buzzers relating to the 1-2½ minute clock at any time during the show, it will result in a \$200 fine per occurrence. (i.e.- second buzzer is \$200 fine, third buzzer is an additional \$200 fine, etc.) THIS WILL BE ENFORCED. (costs here are plus GST to equal above \$220 value)
