TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The vendor must be a FULL member of the NCHA Inc.
2. All horses must be available for inspection prior to the sale.
3. Horses must be presented to the satisfaction of the appointed association inspectors. The inspectors may reject a horse from the sale if the horse does not comply with the following conditions.
 - (a) Markings and brands described on the entry form must be clearly visible and identical to the horse presented for inspection.
 - (b) The horse should be prepared and presented suitably for the sale.
 - (c) The horse should be free of undesirable characteristics and conformation faults.
4. Entry forms must be completed in full and presented to the NCHA by close of business 5pm Wednesday 1st March 2017 together with payment in full \$880 Inc. Otherwise entry will be returned and not accepted.
5. NCHA / Landmark reserve the right to restrict the number of entries.
6. Horses for the sale will be selected by criteria.
7. Vendors entering two (2) year old horses are required to submit a video of their horses working with nomination form for the selection committee to view and decide suitability to the NCHA Select Sale.
8. There will be no refunds on acceptance of nominated horse/s into the Select Sale Catalogue.
9. **At the completion of the Sale, all Vendor's horses sold through Landmark will be refunded the \$330.00 (inc gst) Marketing Fee which will be credited to the Net Proceeds of the Sale.**
10. Vendors are advised that in line with NCHA / Landmark Drug policy on prohibited substances in horses that random drug tests may be carried out for lots consigned to the sale both prior to sale and following that lot having been offered for sale. Positive results from this testing may result in any catalogued lot being rejected from the sale or appropriate funds derived from the sale of such lot being withheld.
11. Commission of 8.0% (+ GST) of the gross purchase price of each lot will be deducted from the gross proceeds by the Acting Agent.
12. Vendors will be provided with a full copy of the conditions of sale.
13. Any information supplied on the nomination form that is found to be inaccurate or misleading may result in immediate disqualification from the sale and nomination fees will be forfeited. Any vendor discovered misrepresenting a sale horse does so at the risk of being charged with a federal offence.
14. The agent reserves the right to sell the horse out of catalogue order and/or reject any horse from the sale.
15. Vendors will be given the opportunity of working their sale horses on cattle during the selling of the said sale horse (Applicable for two (2) year old and trained horses only).
16. Landmark reserves the right to edit/alter catalogue notes.
17. Horses being worked on cattle are required to submit a video of the horse being worked for viewing during the Futurity. Videos to be submitted with nomination form.

19. Embryos must be planted into a recipient mare and the recipient mare will become the property of the purchaser. The recipient mare must provide a positive test result 30 days prior to the sale.

2017 SALE INCENTIVES

\$30,000 Non Pro Futurity Incentive

1. Yearlings entered at the 2017 NCHA Sale **MUST BE SOLD** at this auction to be eligible.
2. This incentive is for three year olds that are entered in the 2019 Non Pro Futurity.
3. \$30,000 will be paid out to the winners and placegetters.
4. 30 % of eligible sale horses or a minimum of four that finish with the highest scores after two go rounds of the Non Pro Futurity will contest a final.
5. All competitors in this sale incentive final will receive prize money.
6. There will be a vendor bonus of \$5,000.00 to the vendor of the winning sale incentive horse.

\$75,000 Open Futurity Yearling Incentive

Futurity Horses will be eligible to compete for the incentive providing that;

1. Only Yearlings offered for sale at the 2017 NCHA Select Sale will be eligible in 2019.
2. The sale horse is nominated by the vendor as provided on the entry form and the fee of \$550.00 (inc GST) is paid with the entry form.
3. In the event that a yearling has not been nominated by the vendor then the purchaser may nominate the purchased yearling and pay the fee of \$550.00 (inc GST) as provided for on the buyer instruction slip handed to the agents conducting the sale.
4. Yearlings must be either sold under the Hammer or sold through the agents by 5pm the day following the sale and must be nominated and the fee paid as per rule 2 or 3.
5. Horses nominated on the entry form and paid for by the vendor pre-sale and passed in will remain eligible to compete for the incentive prize providing that the full commission is paid by the vendor to the agent by 5 pm the day following the sale calculated on the reserve price set by the vendor with the agent prior to sale in writing.
6. Horses nominated and paid for by the vendor and passed in and no commission is paid to the agent as per rule 5 the nominated horse will be ineligible to compete for the incentive and the nomination fee of \$550.00 will be refunded by the NCHA to the vendor.
7. The NCHA will recognise the eligibility of those yearlings nominated for the incentive in writing following the sale.
8. Once a horse is acknowledged by the NCHA as being eligible for the incentive then that right will be transferable from owner to owner if the horse is on sold prior to the futurity being held.
