Camping and Stabling
At Tatura Park

- No Portable yards to be erected on the grounds
- No Dogs allowed on the ground or inside the Competition Shed or Covered outdoor arena
- Stable cost includes sawdust. Clean out fee must be paid when booking stables. This will be refunded after inspection of stables. Stables to be thoroughly cleaned out (all bedding, manure, hay to be removed) and placed at the end of the stable block, not in alleyways.
- No lighting of campfires allowed
- Horses are not to be left tethered to trucks, goosenecks, vehicles or trees.
