- 1. All participants (including spectators and officials) to sign registration form upon entry to facility.
- 2. No participants (including spectators and officials) who have attended Victoria prior to the commencement date in the past 14 days may attend.
- 3. No participants (including spectators and officials) who have attended any of the reported case locations listed on the NSW Health website, may attend.
- 4. If you have travelled overseas / interstate recently, or have recently been in contact with someone who has a confirmed case of COVID-19 do not attend.
- 5. Identify if you have had or in the last 14 days have you been cleared of having COVID 19
- Anyone with respiratory symptoms, such as cough, sore/scratchy throat or shortness
  of breath or unexplained fever should contact COVID SAFTEY OFFICER
  immediately so to self-isolate and be tested for COVID-19.
- 7. Attendees to be only participants, staff, owners of horses, event contractors and local authorities.
- 8. Practice social distancing rules as identified through displayed signage to include:

  - ii. 4sq m rule applies
  - iii. Do not shake hands.
  - iv. Bring your own chair
